

Section 2. Active Members

Active Members comprise the governing body and voting membership of the club. They shall share all the rights, privileges and responsibilities of the club. Active members are eligible to hold elective or appointed office. They shall be entitled to a proportionate share of the assets, if any, in the event of dissolution of the club. Active members are required to attend the spring and fall work parties.

- A. Only voting members in good standing may vote upon active status applicants. The vote shall be by secret ballot at a regular meeting and five negative votes shall reject it and membership will be terminated. Applicants shall be notified of the results by mail.
- B. Active members can designate their spouse or significant other as a family member. The definition of a family member is that of a flag member with no obligation for work parties, attending meetings or becoming an active member after one year.
- C. Exception – a family member, who was an active member before June 2017 will have grandfathered voting rights, can hold elective or appointed office. No other rights will be extended to the grandfathered member. The grandfathered member will pay 50% of the annual dues for this right.

Change- Add “or Flag” member to B.

Justification- Allows a Flag member to designate their spouse or significant other as a family member.

- B. Active **or Flag** members can designate their spouse or significant other as a family member. The definition of a family member is that of a flag member with no obligation for work parties, attending meetings or becoming an active member after one year.
